

Pool, Grounds & Clubhouse Regulations

General Regulations

- The grounds/clubhouse must be cleaned immediately following an event. Please refer to the detailed “Clubhouse and Grounds Checklist” for a list of cleanup duties for which the hosting member is responsible. The cleaning deposit will not be returned if cleanup duties have not been completed by the evening of the event.
- It is recommended that the hosting party check the clubhouse one day prior to the event to ensure that the facilities are in acceptable condition for rental.
- The gate must be closed at all times.
- Decorating must be approved by the Clubhouse Director. Only masking tape is allowed on the inside and outside clubhouse walls.
- No glass is allowed outside of the clubhouse.
- Please bring your own plastic trash bag liners and use them inside the trash cans. All trash must be taken home at the end of the party. Recyclables can be left in recycle bins on the side of the clubhouse.
- The hosting member will be responsible for the following upon departure from the club:
 - Turn off all lights before leaving the grounds and clubhouse.
 - Lock the doors on all sides.
 - Lock the front gate before leaving.

Private Party Supervision

There must be one adult 21 years of age or older in attendance at the event for every 10 children present under the age of 18.

The hosting member **MUST** be present during the entire length of the event and is responsible for the facility. The hosting member and other adults must keep a close eye on guests, including children, and occasionally check in on the condition of restrooms during the party to ensure a safe and clean environment for all members and guests using the club.

Lifeguards have the final authority in the enforcement of all rules, including those pertaining to safety, and have the right and responsibility to eject members or guests who refuse to comply with club regulations. Matters of safety that are not covered by pool regulations will be under the jurisdiction of the club lifeguard when the pool is open to the general membership and under the jurisdiction of the hosting member's lifeguard when the pool is closed to the general membership. When there is no lifeguard on duty, the hosting member is responsible for the supervision and safety of all guests.
